App. E	Scoring Rules: Resident Mood Interview Total Severity Score D0160	E-1	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>The following rules explain how to compute the score that is placed in item D0160. These rules consider the “number of missing items in Column 2”, which is the number of items in Column 2 that are blank (or skipped) <b>or dashed</b>. An item in Column 2 could be blank if the corresponding item in Column 1 was equal to 9, No response or a dash (symptom not assessed).</li> <li>If all of the items in Column 2 have a value of 0, 1, 2, or 3 (i.e., they all contain non-missing values), then item D0160 is equal to the simple sum of those values.</li> <li>If any of the items in Column 2 are blank (or skipped) <b>or dashed</b>, then omit their values when computing the sum.</li> </ul>
App. E	Scoring Rules: Resident Mood Interview Total Severity Score: D0160	E-2	<p>In this example, all of the items in Column 2 have non-missing values (i.e., none of the values are blank <b>or dashed</b>). Therefore, the value of D0160 is equal to the simple sum of the values in Column 2, which is 14.</p>
